


OBJECTIVES

Further refine the digital prototype for users flowing through and completing the task of booking a flight.

To define the details required for developers to build the app accurately.


Notifications



Home Screen

Typical Menu: Appears on every standard screen (not including dialogue boxes).

- Home icon: On selection user is brought to Home Screen.
- <u>Deals icon:</u> On selection user is brought to screen showing current deals and promotions.
- Account icon: On selection user is brought to log in screen if not already signed in. If user is logged in, displays list of booked flights and other account information.
- More icon: On selection, drawer menu appears from the right-hand side displaying other app functions.



Flight Search


Typical Indicator Bar:

Indicator bar at top of each screen tracking booking progress (not including dialogue boxes.)

Automatically populates with closest airport based on GPS location. On selection user brought to departure city dialogue box (3.2.1). Changes to input from departure city dialogue box once selection process is complete.

Automatically populates with most recent search date. On selection user brought to calendar dialogue box (3.3). Changes to input from calendar dialogue box once selection process is complete.

Defaults to 1 Adult. On selection user brought to passengers dialogue box (3.4). Changes to input from passengers dialogue box once selection process is complete. Field will expand to show all passenger types if more than one type selected.



Round Trip – Is shown as default setting. Blue highlighting changes to black when another tab is selected.

One Way – On selection tab is highlighted in blue and brought to the front and "Return" date is removed from available fields.

<u>Multi-City</u> – On selection tab is highlighted in blue and brought to the front and additional fields are provided to allow for selection of additional airports and dates.

Automatically populates with most recent search. On selection user brought to return city dialogue box (3.2.2). Changes to input from return city dialogue box once selection process is complete.


Automatically populates with most recent search. On selection user brought to calendar dialogue box (3.3). Changes to input from calendar dialogue box once selection process is complete.

'(Optional)' text is shown in gray. On selectin user brought to promo code dialogue box. Changes to input from promo code dialogue box once process is complete.


Button will be grey if required fields are incomplete (for example, during first time using app and therefore no recent searches). On selection brings user to departure flights screen (4.1).

To/From Dialogue Box



Dates Dialogue Box



Default to last search date. Oval around date is blue until date is chosen.

Closes dialogue box and returns user to flight search screen (3.1).

Appears if there are earlier dates available.


Disappears when most current month is showing at the top. On selection, previous month will display, and information will slide down.

Default to last search date until departing date is selected. Date will then change to same date as departure date until return date is selected. Oval around date becomes blue when it is time to indicate return date.

Will display calendar starting on current month with dates prior to the current date greyed out. Future months can be accessed by clicking on downward arrow or by swiping up. Dates to be highlighted in blue once selected with start and end dates in darker blue than dates between flights.

Appears when a departure and return dates are selected. On selection user returns to flight search screen (3.1).

On selection, next month will display, and information will slide up.

Departure Flights

Back arrow: On selection user returns to flight search screen (3.1).

Sort by: Time: Highlighted in blue to indicate default sort. Button becomes black/white when another Sort by button is selected. Flights are displayed in order of departure time with non-stop flights showing before flights with stopovers.

<u>Sort by: \$:</u> On selection will be highlighted in blue and flight options will reorganize to display lowest fare at the top.

<u>Sort by: Duration:</u> On selection will be highlighted in blue and flight options will reorganize to display shortest trip at the top.




Displays date and lowest fare for that date.

Defaults to departure date selected during flight search (middle tab) and is indicated with blue highlighting. Left tab displays date previous and right tab displays date after. Blue outline appears and tab is brough to the front when selected.

Flights: On selection user will be taken to fare option dialogue box (4.1.2).


Return Flights

Back arrow: On selection user returns to departure flights screen (4.1.1).

Sort by: Time: Highlighted in blue to indicate default sort. Button becomes black/white when another Sort by button is selected. Flights are displayed in order of departure time with non-stop flights showing before flights with stopovers.

<u>Sort by: \$:</u> On selection will be highlighted in blue and flight options will reorganize to display lowest fare at the top.

<u>Sort by: Duration:</u> On selection will be highlighted in blue and flight options will reorganize to display shortest trip at the top.




Displays date and lowest fare for that date.


Return Flights



Flight Summary

Back arrow: On selection user returns to return flights screen (4.2.1).

On selection user is brought to screen with options to share flight summary. Available options based on device operating system and relevant apps installed on device.



On selection user is brought to screen with option to save flight within app. User will be brought to log in screen if not already signed in.


On selection user is brought to sign in screen (5.1) or if already signed in brings user directly to passenger info screen (5.2).

Sign In Screen

Back arrow: On selection user returns to flight summary screen (4.3). **Passenger Info** Do you have an account? **SIGN IN** On selection user brought to log in screen. No account? On selection user is brought to sign up form screen. SIGN UP On selection use is brought to passenger info CONTINUE AS A GUEST screen (5.2). •••




Passenger Type


Back arrow: On selection user returns to previous screen state. On selection panel animates to expand to open Passenger #1 state or contract to closed state - arrow **ADULT** CHILD direction changes accordingly to indicate INFANT open/close. On selection, passenger type First Name: (Adult, Child or Infant) is highlighted in orange. **Last Name:** When collapsed, only selected passenger type will show in field. 

On selection a blinking cursor appears in field and NUMBER pad appears. Digits autoformat to standard 10-digit telephone number (###) ###-####. Selecting 'Enter' will confirm text and move cursor to next field with a change keyboard type as required.

On selection a blinking cursor appears in field and NUMBER pad appears. Selecting 'Enter' will confirm text and close NUMBER pad.

Remains grey until all required information on form is filled in.

Assistance Info



Back arrow: On selection user returns to previous screen state.

On selection panel animates to expand to open state or contract to closed state – arrow type changes accordingly to indicate open/close. If options are selected, options will appear as list in closed state.

On selection the circle next to special requirement option changes to green and a checkmark becomes visible.



On selection user is brought to a dialogue box with detailed information with definitions of each item listed as a special requirement.


Remains grey until all required information on form is filled in.

Passenger Summary

Back arrow: On selection user returns to passenger info screen (5.7).



On selection user is brought to seat selection screen (6.1).

Seat Selection


Back arrow: On selection user returns to passenger summary screen (5.8).




On selection user is brought to seat dialogue box (6.2) featuring seat map. Buttons change to blue and text shows seat chosen once seat selection process has taken place through the seat dialogue box (6.2).

On selection user is brought to flight extras screen (7.1).

Seat Dialogue Box





Closes dialogue box and returns user to seat selection screen (6.1). Selections are not preserved.

Same seat button only appears when return flight seats are being chosen and same seat as departing flight is available. On selection, same seat as departing flight is highlighted in seat map.

When selecting seat for second passenger, seat for first passenger is highlighted in seat map.

Appears only when there are portions of the form not shown below the current visible section of the screen. On selection, information will slide up. Swiping up will also reveal hidden information.

Is grey until selection is made. On selection user is brought back to seat selection screen (6.1).

Seat is highlighted in blue once selected. Text indicates which passenger seat has been assigned to. For example, P1 = Passenger #1.

Fight Extras

Back arrow: On selection user returns to previous screen state.

On selection a dialogue box to select insurance options appears (7.3). Shows type and cost of insurance once selected or indicates 'no insurance' if no insurance selected.

On selection a dialogue box to coordinate a car rental appears. Shows type and cost of rental once selected or 'no rental' if no car rental selected.




On selection a dialogue box for baggage selection appears (7.2). Shows number and cost of bags once selected or indicates 'no baggage' if no bags selected.

On selection a dialogue box to select from food voucher options appears. Shows type and value of voucher once selected or indicates 'no vouchers' if no food vouches selected.


Remains grey until all fields on the form are filled in. Once information is complete is highlighted in blue and can be selected. On selection user is brought to cost summary screen (8.1).



Back arrow: On selection user returns to flight extras (7.1)



On selection user is brought to payment options screen (8.2) .

Back arrow: On selection user returns to cost summary (8.1)




Payment method icons: On selection user is taken to a screen showing fields appropriate for the payment type. For example, Mastercard users will see Credit Card entry screen (8.3)

Payment Screen

Back arrow: On selection user returns previous screen state.

Sample text is shown in grey until information is input. On selection NUMBER pad appears (8.4). Shows card number in standard 16-digit credit card number format #### #### #### once entered.

Sample text is shown in grey until information is input. On selection NUMBER pad appears (8.4). Shows expiry date in standard 4-digit credit card expiry date format ##/## once entered.



Sample text is shown in grey until information is input. On selection NUMBER pad appears (8.4). Shows security ID number in standard 3-digit security ID format ###.

On selection QWERTY keypad appears (8.4). Shows name of cardholder. Once entered.


Once information is complete is highlighted in blue and can be selected. On selection user is brought to confirmation screen (9).

Enter Exp/Sec ID

Back arrow: On selection user returns previous screen state.

Sample text is shown in grey until information is input. On selection a blinking cursor appears in field and NUMBER pad appears. Digits autoformat to standard 16-digit credit card number length #### #### ####. When 'Enter' on NUMBER pad is selected, cursor moves to Exp: field.

Sample text is shown in grey until information is input. On selection a blinking cursor appears in field and NUMBER pad appears. Digits autoformat to standard 4-digit credit card expiry date format ##/##. When 'Enter' on NUMBER pad is selected, cursor moves to Sec ID: field.




On selection user is brought to a dialogue box with information about where to find security ID on credit card.

Sample text is shown in grey until information is input. On selection a blinking cursor appears in field and NUMBER pad appears. Digits autoformat to standard 3-digit security ID format ###. NUMBER pad is hidden when 'Enter' is selected.

Enter Name

Back arrow: On selection user returns previous screen state.




On selection a blinking cursor appears in field and QWERTY keyboard appears. Selecting 'Enter' on keyboard will hide keyboard.

Confirmation

Back arrow: On selection user returns to payment screen (8.3).

On selection user is brought to screen with options to share flight summary. Available options based on device operating system and relevant apps installed on device.

On selection user is brought to list of bookings saved on the app.



On selection user is brough to screen with options to add to calendar. Available options based on operating system and relevant apps installed on device.

On selection user is brought to flight search screen (3.1).
